



Event description:	

International multidisciplinary discussion seminar was organised by the Czech-Austrian Energy Expert Group (CZ-AT EEG) in cooperation with the Czech Technical University in Prague, the Vienna University of Technology, the Institute for Economic and Environmental Policy (Jan Evangelista Purkyně University in Ústí nad Labem) and the Czech Solar Association.

The goal was to discuss important steps towards the climate neutrality goal in Europe. The transformation of the energy sector is also bringing new solutions, many of which are in the solar sector such as floating PV, Agrivoltaics, building-integrated PV, or Vehicle-integrated PV. These sub-parts of solar energy can be very important supplements to rooftop and utility-scale solar energy, which are still crucial. Very closely connected are battery storages, flexibility or **development of electric vehicles**, **and related infrastructure needs**. To build a strong and secure future energy mix, all above mentioned solutions need to be developed together.

During the workshop experts from diverse backgrounds and entities have discussed what opportunities and challenges bring the energy policy changes and energy transformation for Central European countries and what are the pathways to overcome these challenges.

In the scope of this event Amela Ajanovic and Reinhard Haas have presented two topics relevant for the PELMOB project: "Renewable Energy in the Transport Sector" and "The Role of Renewable Energy in European Electricity Generation".

We have used this opportunity to actively promote PELMOB project, highlighting its core ideas. The interactive discussion with audience reflected high importance of and interest in sustainable E-mobility.
