Event description:	<p>The 8th AIEE Energy Symposium on Energy Security is organized by the Italian Association of Energy Economists – AIEE (www.aiee.it), the Italian affiliate of the IAEE (www.iaee.org), with the scientific contribution of the Interdepartmental Centre “Giorgio Levi Cases” for Energy Economy and Technology at the University of Padua.</p> <p>At this event, emerging security challenges and opportunities resulting from global efforts to lower CO2 emissions by reducing consumption of high-carbon energy sources were addressed with the focus on the impact of climate change on the global energy system considering both mitigation and adaptation actions and their possible impacts on the transition roadmap toward a decarbonized system. 
