

Airport - Chalkida by Train

The easiest way to reach Evripos Campus is using the Suburban Railway. From the airport you take the Suburban Railway (proastiakos) to SKA interchange. At SKA interchange you take the train to Chalkida. All hotels are located within a few minutes walking distance from the train station. Also, some hotels offer transportation from and to the airport.

Athens Airport - Athens centre - Evripos University Campus (Bus)

For those who wish to stay in Athens you may get to Athens centre via metro, suburban railway, bus or taxi:

To get from Athens to the Evripos Campus, the easiest way is to take a bus which runs daily between <u>KTEL bus station at Liossion str</u> and the Evripos Campus:

- ATHENS NKUA Evripos Campus: 6.30, 9.00, 10.00, 11.00, 12.00, 13.00, 14.00, 16.00, 17.00, 18.00
- NKUA Evripos Campus ATHENS: 9.15, 10.15, 11.15, 13.30, 14.30, 15.30, 16.30, 17.30, 18.30, 17.30

- The prices are valid for taxis that are booked through our team. For regular prices check the taxi apps (Free Now, Taxi EU, Uber, Gett e.tc.)
- Each taxi can take up to 4 passengers.
- A google form is available for those who will use taxi from the above suggested list so that we can book it for you here: https://forms.gle/f4ukwrvRRb3KCv4T9
- The taxi routes to and from the airport must be booked 24hours prior and the company needs to know the flight that you are taking and what is the arrival or boarding time (accordingly)
- The taxi only takes cash, you cannot pay via card or mobile app. Receipts can be issued in the cab normally (ask for it).
